Rockwell Automation is committed to meeting our legal obligations under WEEE and has a program in place to ensure compliance for in-scope products.

European Directive 2002/95/EC—*The Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS)* restricts the use of six hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. Rockwell Automation products falling within the scope of the RoHS Directive are computer products such as industrial computers, monitors, and accessories. Rockwell Automation products that fall within the scope of the RoHS Directive are fully compliant. Furthermore, Rockwell Automation's long-term goal is to meet the RoHS material restrictions for all products in accordance with the EU RoHS Recast, European Directive 2011/65/EU, prior to 2017.
