

# Guidelines

## Focused Giving

**The Rockwell Automation Charitable Corporation Board has identified Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) education, particularly in grades K-12, as the Company's focused giving area.**

Rockwell Automation has long, well-established partnerships to address the above subject area and is accepting a limited number of unsolicited requests.

Rockwell Automation also contributes to Arts and Culture, Health and Human Services, and limited Civic organizations. However, the majority of gifts to these organizations are made through Rockwell Automation United Way corporate contributions and local federated Arts and Culture campaigns. We are **not** pursuing additional community partners in these areas of focus.

## Grant Submission

The Rockwell Automation Charitable Corporation focuses its funding on communities where we have a larger presence, such as Milwaukee, WI and Cleveland, OH. Our major facilities in these cities evaluate grant applications and determine/prioritize need in the community. Grant requests for national programs should be submitted to the Rockwell Automation Charitable Corporation Administrator at our Global Headquarters in Milwaukee, WI.

Grant requests **must** align with our *Focused Giving* referenced in the section above.

## Limitations and Restrictions

Organizations are not eligible for consideration if they have not received a permanent, tax-exempt ruling determination from the federal government, or if they cannot provide current full, certified, audited financial statements, or if they are private foundations.

Funding from Rockwell Automation should **not** be requested for the following purposes:

- Grants to individuals
- Organizations headquartered outside the United States
- Religious organizations for religious purposes
- Fraternal or social organizations
- Unsolicited capital campaigns
- Unsolicited multi-year pledges

The Company will not make any contributions to any individual, entity or organization that commits, attempts to commit, advocates, facilitates, or participates in terrorist acts or has committed, attempted to commit, facilitated, or participated in terrorist acts.

If you are a current Rockwell Automation community partner or a new grantee requesting funding directly related to our educational focus outlined above, you are requested to complete the grant application provided and submit it to the local Rockwell Automation Community Affairs administrator.
