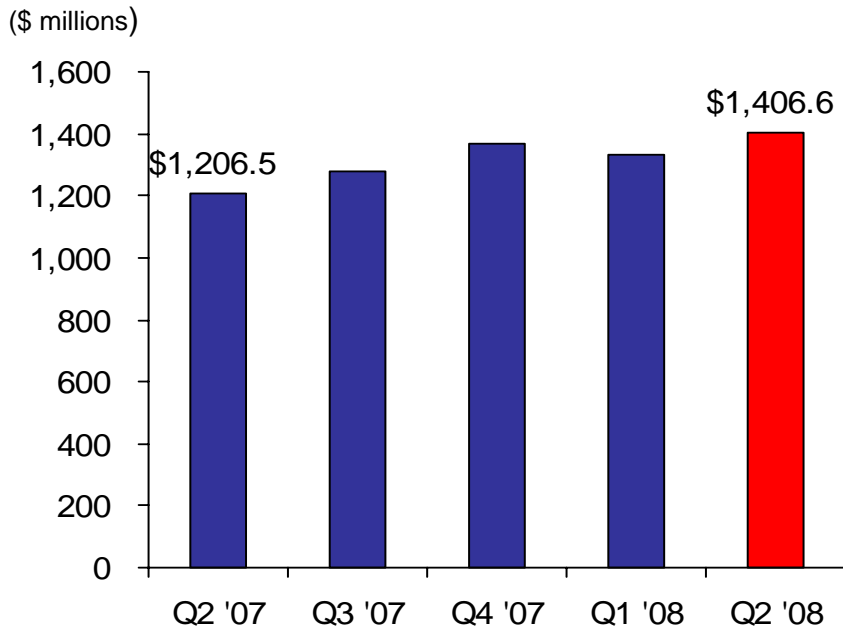

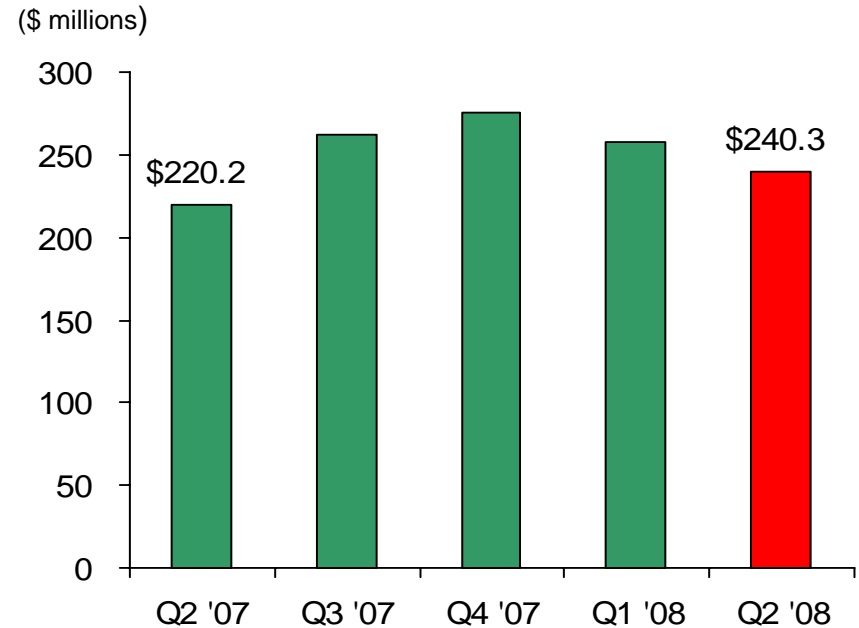
Q2 Results: Rockwell Automation

- Strong YOY growth in the Americas; continued improvement in Asia

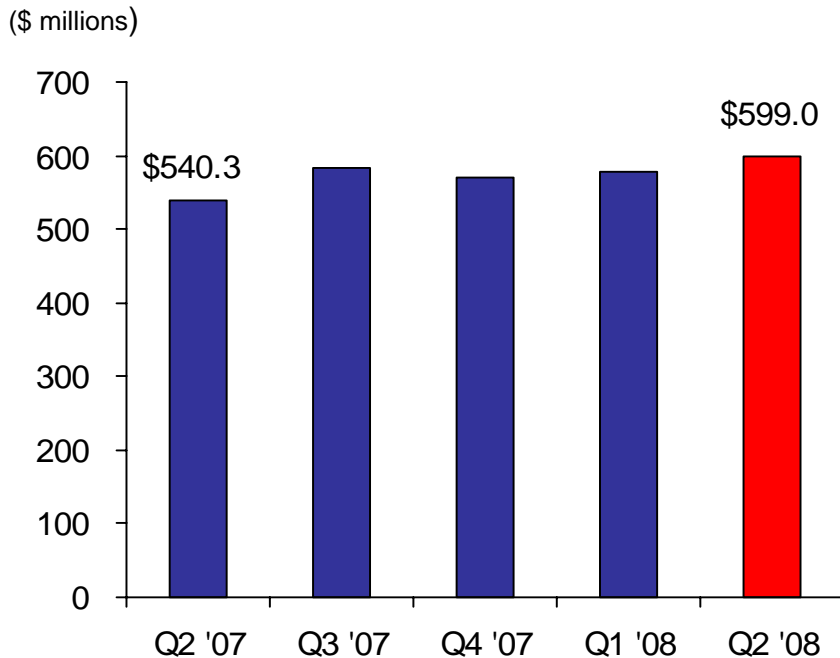
Segment Operating Earnings

- Margin lower due to business mix, acquisitions, investment spending and foreign currency impacts

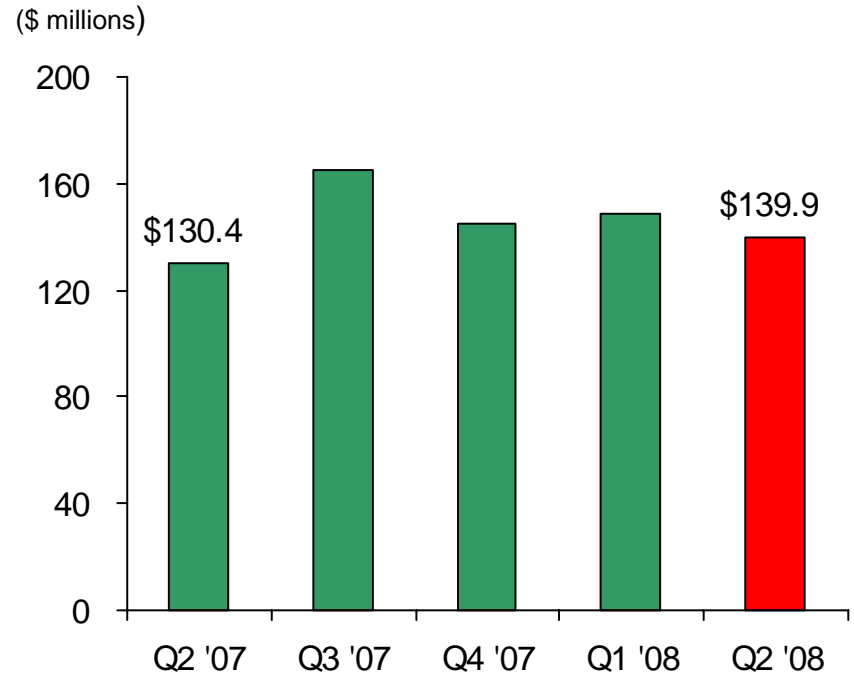
Q2 Results: Architecture & Software

- Sales increased 4% sequentially

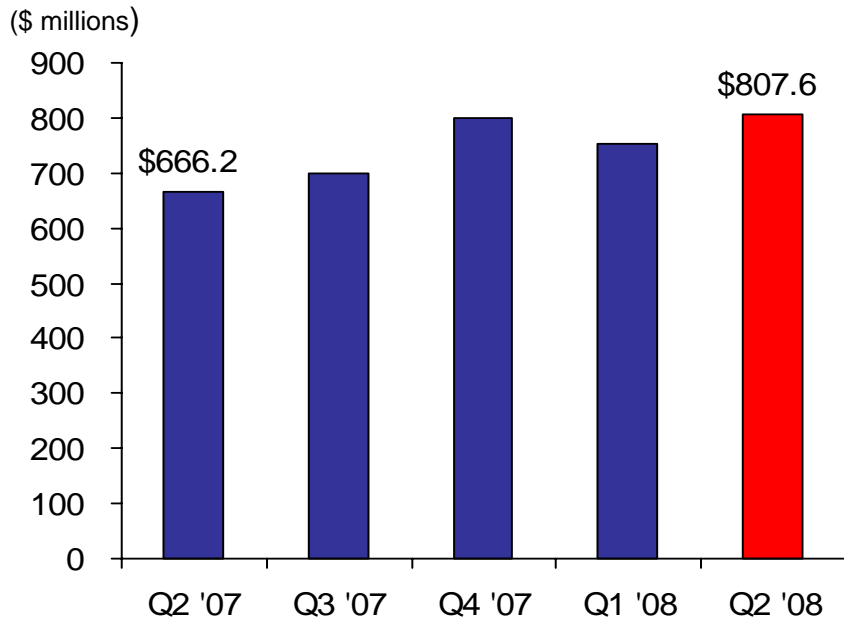
Segment Operating Earnings

- Segment operating margin contracted 0.7 pts. YOY to 23.4% due to inflation and increased investment spending partially offset by volume leverage and productivity

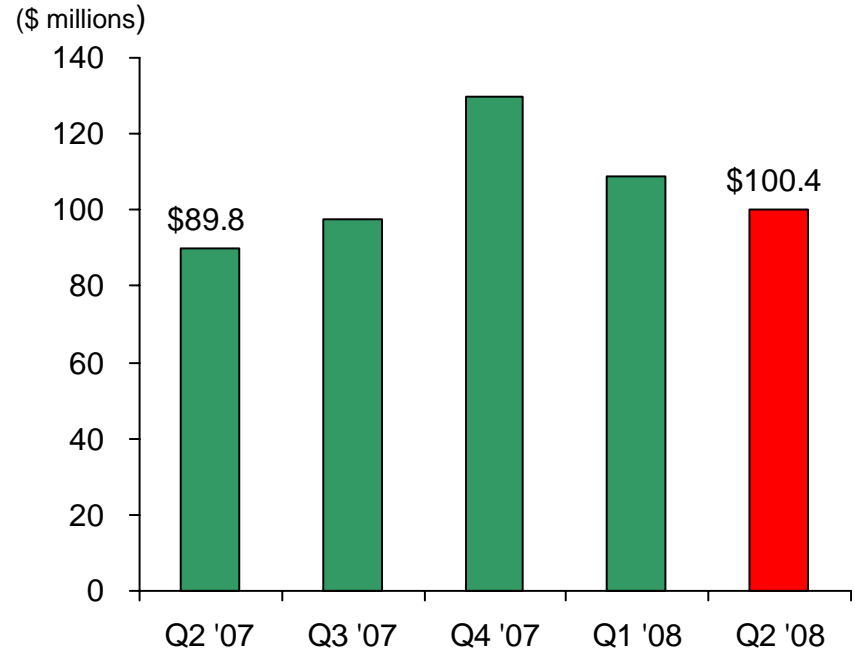
Q2 Results: Control Products & Solutions
